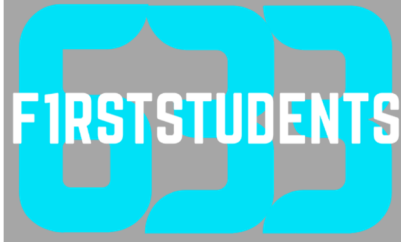

The Mission of FBC, Pascagoula:
Leading people to become fully devoted followers of Jesus

I hope that you've been as fired up in hearing about our mission as I have been in sharing it with you. The above statement represents months of prayer and discussion. I truly believe that if, as a church, we let this mission statement drive us into the future, we will see God work in ways we could scarcely imagine. We have been taking time to unpack it to understand what it really means:

- **Leading people-** FBC must take the initiative in pursuing people with the gospel of Jesus and investing in their lives afterward.
- **To become-** FBC must understand that the critical assumption of this mission is that our church become a place where people's lives are being transformed daily into the image of Jesus.
- **Fully devoted followers of Jesus-** I'll share this coming Sunday that our goal is to develop disciples who trust Jesus, obey Jesus, and follow Jesus on his mission.

If the Lord wills, we will come together in the week following Mother's Day to consider adopting this as FBC Pascagoula's new mission statement. I want to urge you to pray about it. Why? I've told you before that we aren't simply looking to approve a statement. Rather the hope is that we genuinely take this as our mission, so much so that it changes the way we think, value, and operate as a church.
